Caradon Hosts Energy Efficiency Roadshow

In line with the Energy Saving Trust's Energy Saving Week 23rd October to 27th October, the Cornwall Energy Efficiency Advice Centre (EEAC) is out and about across the county, offering energy efficiency and renewable technology advice to help households save money on their fuel bills and reduce carbon emissions.

The Advice team will be in the Reception at Caradon District Council in Liskeard on Friday 20th October ready to answer questions and give advice on financial and practical ways to save energy in the home.

Dave Barnett, Environmental Health Officer at Caradon District Council said, ***"We fully support the Cornwall Energy Efficiency Advice Centre and the work they do with regard to impartial advice to our residents. We welcome the advice team to our offices so that all the district's residents have the opportunity to find out what grants and assistance are available to them."***

Currently, the average household could save up to £300 a year by being more energy efficient. This is equivalent to a saving of around 2 tonnes of carbon dioxide – enough to fill 2 balloons 10 meters in diameter.*

Julia Tibbett, Advice Team Manager for the Cornwall EEAC said ***"With fuel bills rising it's affecting us all. If you come along to the events we are planning, our friendly advisors can tell you about grants for insulations and renewables. We also offer advice on changing suppliers, fuel debt and much, much more. All our information is free and impartial and you may also win a prize."***

Along with additional advice on small scale renewable technologies including; micro-wind turbines, solar panels for hot water and electricity and ground source heat pumps, South West Water will be along for the ride at the Cornwall Roadshow events to provide valuable information on water conservation.
