On 1<sup>st</sup> April the CSEP team will become the core of 'Low Carbon Cornwall' (LCC) and will be based within the new Cornwall Development Company (CDC).

The changes form part of the reorganisation of Cornwall's public services and will place the delivery of **low carbon** objectives as one of the highest strategic priorities in Cornwall.

LCC will be playing a central role in co-ordinating, facilitating and managing the priority low carbon delivery objectives for Cornwall. Whilst it will sit within the new CDC, it will be outward facing, working with partners in Cornwall, the South West, nationally and internationally.

Importantly, LCC will be the delivery catalyst between the public and private sectors. Its work will be to facilitate a low carbon economic programme, delivered primarily by the private sector and procured/facilitated by the public and third sectors. The aim is to create a local mechanism for multi-sector delivery of objectives based upon the recommendations of Lord Stern. Our ambition is to become an exemplar to the rest of the UK and Europe.

The work of CSEP will be rationalised, managed and delivered through LCC. In effect, CSEP will, in the longer term will be more focused in being the delivery partnership for the Cornwall Climate Change Action Plan.

Not only will LCC have a core of a skilled team, it will also have outward looking 'satellite' posts linked to key organisations that will have a major responsibility for delivering low carbon objectives. Some of these 'satellite' posts will be in place within the coming months whilst others are still being progressed. Please contact us if you are interested in discussing such links with your organisation.

Some of the key 'core' positions within LCC are still to be appointed. Two posts, a technical officer and a partnership co-ordinator, will be advertised in the next few weeks.
